Dana Point Farm: A Chance Partnership

A certain amount of both fate and faith were instrumental in the founding and expanding of Dana Point Farm. Now the perseverance shown by farm owner Gayle Gerth and manager Maria Vorhauer has begun to pay dividends as they bolster their stallion roster with the addition of Grade 1 winner Swagger Jack and enjoy the race-track prowess of dual stakes winner R Frosty One.

The road has been far from easy for Gerth and Vorhauer. They met by chance

offered to Pennsylvania-Breds. They found a crumbling property in Lenhartsville and immediately envisioned its potential.

Dana Point Farm was opened in the summer of 2008, named in honor of the seaside town of Dana Point where Gerth resides in California. The mares moved in, stallions were being acquired and the future seemed limitless.

Then the stock market crashed on Sept. 29. "The entire economy fell," Vorhauer said. "Kudos to Gayle that she stuck

On March 27, 2010, a chestnut son of Wiseman's Ferry named Wise Dan broke his maiden at Turfway Park by 15¼ lengths. He reeled off three straight wins and for the next two seasons added the odd stakes race to his resume, such as the Firecracker Handicap-G2 and the Phoenix Stakes-G3. At the end of 2011 Wise Dan won the Fayette Stakes-G2 by four lengths and nabbed his first Grade 1 in the Clark Handicap in consecutive starts.

"We were very blessed that we had



bumping into each other at the New York Breeders' Sales Company's fall mixed sale in 2007. Gerth was only there because she was attending a nearby family wedding but she found herself immediately smitten with the auction process. She ran into Vorhauer again later and they bought a first pair of mares together followed by another pair.

Gerth quickly decided she needed her own place to keep the mares and Vorhauer had long since sold her on the rewards

with it because financially it was tough."

In November, less than two months after the crash, it was announced that Wiseman's Ferry would relocate to Dana Point Farm from Castleton Lyons in Kentucky for the 2009 breeding season. At the time Wiseman's Ferry had 39 winners and four stakes horses and Pennsylvania seemed a good fit for the son of Hennessy. Little did Gerth and Vorhauer know Wiseman's Ferry would become their flagship stallion.

success early on," Vorhauer said. "It helped us keep up; even in the tough economic times it all fell together."

Wise Dan went from successful stakes runner to superstar in 2012 winning three straight Grade 1 races including the \$1,818,000 Breeders' Cup Mile and being crowned Eclipse Horse of the Year. He repeated in both the Breeders' Cup and as

Horse of the Year in 2013 and concluded his career in 2014 with a total of 23 wins from 31 starts for earnings of \$7,552,920.

His success brought both calls of congratulations and a host of new mares to Wiseman's Ferry, who continued to stand for a humble fee but whose success propelled the farm through the decade. Just as when the stock market fell, however, Gerth was dealt another blow when Wiseman's Ferry died suddenly of a heart attack on March 17, 2015.

"We weren't sure if we were going to go on," Vorhauer said. "It was tough emotionally and it didn't seem worth it to get another stallion."

Although no stallion can replace Wiseman's Ferry, Swagger Jack is the horse that will try. The son of Smart Strike hails from one of the hottest sire lines on the continent and boasts earnings of \$460,519. He won the \$400,000 Carter Handicap-G1 in 2013 and placed in two graded stakes races at Gulfstream Park.

"We are super excited about this horse," Vorhauer said. "Not only is he good looking physically from one of the hottest sires in the country but he's got a beautiful demeanor.

We've gotten lucky before and are kind of hoping this is another lucky one for us. It's been an emotional ride for us and Wiseman's Ferry was a once in a lifetime kind of horse but now we have that opportunity again with Swagger Jack."

To accept a horse onto the Dana Point roster Vorhauer not only has to like the physical horse and pedigree but also race record and mind. Swagger Jack will be the newest member of the team joining three others already standing at the farm.

Sir Shackleton is a farm favorite. The son of Miswaki won seven of 20 starts and earned \$1,051,500 while taking three graded stakes. He was also second in the Woodward Stakes-G1 and third in the Metropolitan and Whitney Handicaps-G1. Sir Shackleton has 68% starters from foals, and 66% winners from starters.

Southern Success has similar numbers. The stakes-winning son of Dixieland Band out of an A.P. Indy mare has 63% runners from foals and 77% of his starters have won at least once.

Ventana will see his first runners on the track this year. Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert conditioned the son of Toccet to four wins

and earnings of \$383,106. Amongst his victories were the Potrero Grande Handicap-G2 and the Maryland Sprint Handicap-G3.

It isn't just in the shed that Gerth is seeing her dream come to fruition. A filly she bred, R Frosty One, has won five of nine starts including a pair of stakes. R Frosty One, by Southern Success, took the Malvern Rose Stakes at Presque Isle Downs in August before adding the Mrs. Penny Stakes at Parx Racing in September.

"Gayle still owns the mare," Vorhauer said of R Frosty One's dam, the Unbridled Time mare I'm the Mary. "We bought this farm for the Pennsylvania breeders awards and we're seeing those rewards now.

Gerth is currently downsizing, cutting her broodmare band from nearly 30 to an elite group of about six. She has high hopes for an Afleet Alex yearling half-sister to R Frosty One and a Wiseman's Ferry weanling colt from the same mare. "He was the last Wiseman colt born here," Vorhauer said. "He's a little sentimental to us."

After persevering through two different kinds of crises, Gerth and Vorhauer have every reason to look forward to another round of rewards. ★

Pa-Bred Juvenile Stakes To Cap Off Great Year Of Racing

The Blue Mountain Juvenile Fillies and Pennsylvania Nursery, the two remaining stakes on the PA-Bred calendar for 2015, have had a terrific history of showcasing rising talent. In recent years such future graded stakes stars at Hard Spun (2006) and Quantum Miss (2010) have wrapped up their 2-year-old campaigns with wins in the state-bred fixtures. And who can forget the astounding performance by Smarty Jones in 2003—making his stakes debut, he won the Pennsylvania Nursery

by an eye-popping 15 lengths in a smashing time of 1:21.88 for the 7 furlongs.

First up this year will be the \$75,000 Blue Mountain Juvenile Fillies Stakes, set to go 6 furlongs at Penn National on the festive Thanksgiving eve program of Wednesday, Nov. 25. Last year's winner was Rockin Jojo, a winner by a length and a half over seven rivals.

Just over a week later, on Saturday, Dec. 5 at Parx, is the 7-furlong

\$100,000 Pennsylvania Nursery. Smarty Jones' son Nasa got the job done in 2014, winning easily by more than 2 lengths in the field of nine. In his next start, he finished second in the Jerome Stakes-G3 at Aqueduct on Jan. 3.

The two juvenile races wrap up the 2015 22-race stakes schedule which offered \$1.825 million to PA-Bred runners, provided thrilling contests at all three of the state's tracks and showcased PA-Bred talent.

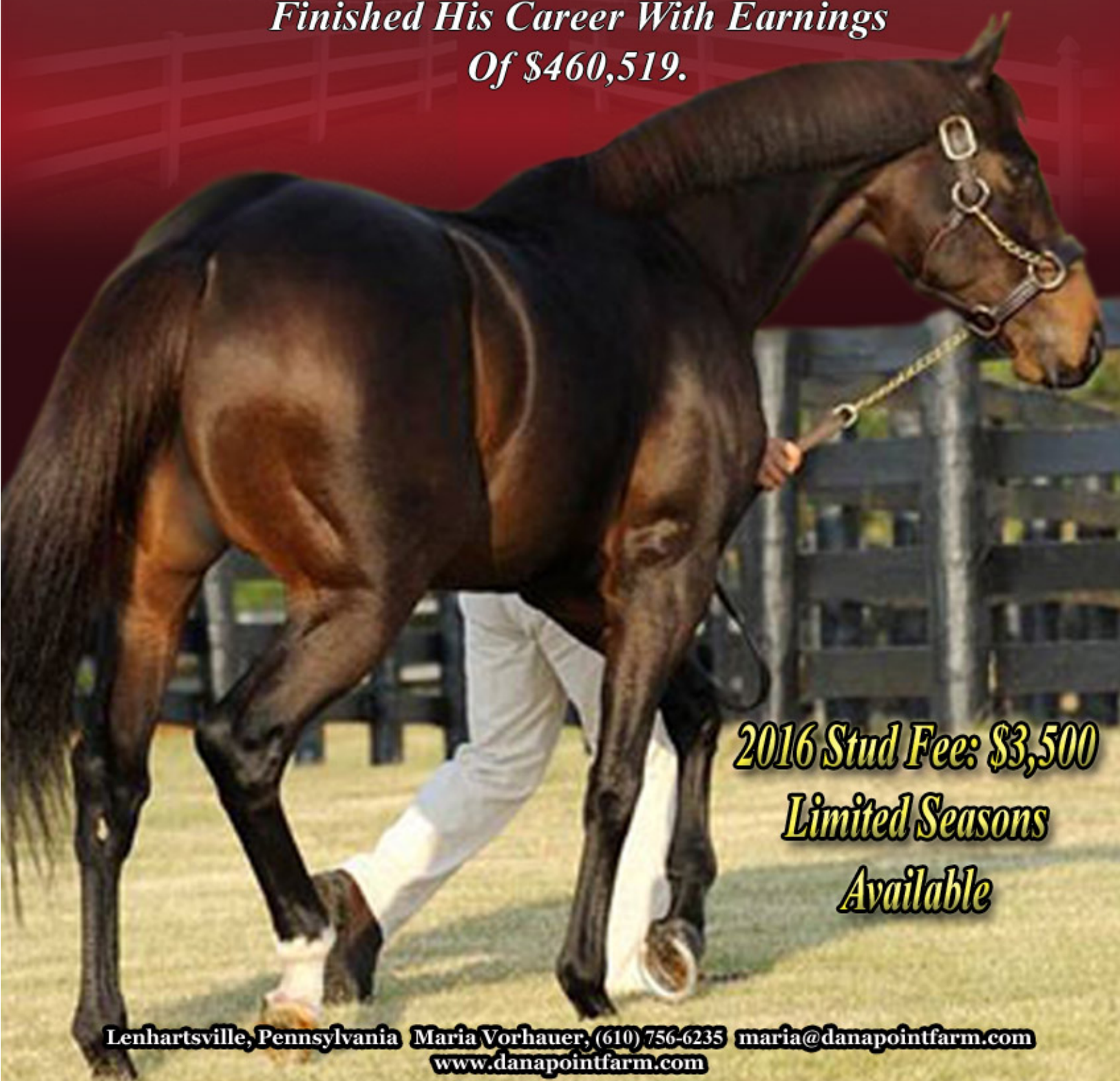

Pennsylvania News Briefs

PA-Bred yearlings at Keeneland & Midlantic

KEENELAND SEPTEMBER

A total of 41 PA-Breds sold for a gross of \$3,479,000 and an average of \$84,854 at the Keeneland September sale, held Sept. 14 through Sept. 26 in Lexington, Ky.

The highest price for a PA-Bred was \$400,000 for the gray or roan filly by Tapit out of Unrivaled Belle, sold by her breeder Brushwood Stable through Eaton Sales. Don Alberto Corporation made the purchase. The filly is the second foal out of Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic-G1 winner Unrivaled Belle, a daughter of Unbridled's Song who amassed \$1,854,706 during her career.

A total of eight PA-Breds sold for six figures. Also hitting the mark were:

FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC

The 64 PA-Breds sold at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Fall Yearlings sale in Timonium, Md., on Oct. 6 grossed \$909,500 and an average of \$14,211.

The most expensive was a colt consigned by breeder Barbara Smith Brown with Bill Reightler, agent, who was purchased for \$85,000 by Samantha Siegel's Jay Em Ess Stable. The son of leading Pennsylvania sire Jump Start out of the Citidancer mare Mrs. Vanderbilt is a half-brother to Delaware Oaks-G2 winner Dancing Afleet and multiple stakes winner Tujoes from the family of Ewer All Wet.

Dame Dorothy offered at Fasig-Tipton KY “Night of Stars”

PA-Bred Grade 1 winner Dame Dorothy has been made a late supplemental entry to Fasig-Tipton Kentucky’s marquee mixed sale, The November Sale, to be held Sunday, Nov. 1 in Lexington, Ky. The sale comes the day after her anticipated start in the \$1 million Breeders’ Cup Filly & Mare Sprint-G1.

The 4-year-old Bernardini filly, bred by Derry Meeting Farm, is the second Grade/Group 1 winner out of Vole Vole Monamour (by Woodman). Her half-sister Mrs. Lindsay won the Prix Vermeille-G1 and E.P. Taylor Stakes-G1 while amassing \$1,201,621, and as a broodmare is the dam of French stakes-winning and classic-placed Mr. Owen. The family descends from Marshall Jenney’s famed champion Mrs. Penny, with members including champion Hatoof, Grade/Group 1 winners Curren Black Hill and Irish Prize, and Whitney Handicap-G1 winner Unaccounted For, a half-brother to Dame Dorothy’s stakes-winning second dam A Votre Sante.

Dame Dorothy was purchased by Bobby Flay as a yearling for \$390,000 at the 2012 Keeneland September Yearling sale. Trained by Todd Pletcher, she has won seven of 11 starts, with graded victories in the Humana Distaff-G1 at Churchill Downs this past May, the Grade 3 Turnback the Alarm and Bed o’ Roses Handicaps at Belmont Park. Her three stakes-placings, all in graded stakes, include a second in this year’s Grade 1 Santa Margarita Stakes. She has current earnings of \$749,740.

The last time Uncle Dave won a stakes race, it was the last day of December 2013 at Turf Paradise in the Luke Kruytbosch. Mrs. Henry D. Paxson Memorial Stakes



Barlar LLC's homebred 2-year-old filly *Imply* remained undefeated in two starts with her nose victory over odds-on choice *Bella Flor* in the Henry D. Paxson Memorial on Sept. 20 at Presque Isle Downs. The chestnut filly set all the fractions, opened up in the stretch and was all out to get to the wire first going six furlongs. It was more than six lengths back to the third-place finisher *Hey Monba*.

Trained by Bernie Houghton, *Imply* broke her maiden in July at Parx going five furlongs on the dirt. She has now earned \$91,530.

By former Pennsylvania stallion *E Dubai*, *Imply* is the second stakes winner out of *Al-lude*, a daughter of *Oriente* purchased by Barlar for \$17,000 in foal to *Divine Park* at the Keeneland November Breeding Stock sale in 2011. After producing a daughter of *Lonhro* (Aus) for Barlar in 2014, the mare was resold for \$100,000 at Keeneland's November sale last year.

Plum Pretty Stakes



For the second year in a row Barlar LLC homebred *Bound* captured the Plum Pretty Stakes at a mile and a sixteenth over Parx's main track. From the first Pennsylvania-sired

crop of *Jump Start*, the 4-year-old filly rallied around the far turn after racing mid-pack early, caught the leader in midstretch and drew off to a length and a half score as the second choice in the field of 10. In 2014, she was much more of a surprise, going off at more than 10-1.

It was the sixth career win from 17 starts for *Bound*, who now has earnings of \$274,014. Her six placings include thirds earlier this year in the Northern Fling Stakes at Presque Isle and Lyphard Stakes at Penn National. The Bernie Houghton trainee was also second in the 2014 Malvern Rose Stakes at Presque Isle.

Bound is the last reported foal for her dam *China Sky* (by *Skywalker*), and is a half-sister to stakes winners *Lune Rouge* and *Road to Mandalay* (the dam of stakes winner *La Concerto*), plus graded stakes-placed *Justice for Auston*. She is entered in the Keeneland November Breeding Stock sale (hip 1334, Book 3) which puts her in the ring on Friday, Nov. 6. ✪

1991, by Cozzene - Illiterate, by Arts and Letters. Bred by Southeast Associates; owned by Georgia B. Ridder; trained by David Hofmans.

The leading money-earning Pennsylvania-bred of all time when he retired in 1997 with a career total of \$2,990,270, Alphabet Soup gave Pennsylvania some of its proudest moments in history with his victory in the \$4-million Breeders' Cup Classic-G1—North America's richest Thoroughbred race—in

1996 at Woodbine. It was a heart-stopping finish, with the handsome roan scoring by a nose over Preakness winner Louis Quatorze, and "Horse of the World" Cigar a close third, in new track record time of 2:01 for the mile and a quarter.

Alphabet Soup was foaled at Frank and Mary Lapos' Center Hill Farm because his breeder Roy Lerman of Middleburg, Va., had hoped that the horse might one day take advantage of the PA breeding program. Purchased privately as an unraced 2-year-old by owner Georgia B. Ridder after twice failing to make his reserve (he was a \$28,000 RNA at

Keeneland in September and a \$29,000 RNA the following spring at the 1993 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic 2-year-olds in training sale), Alphabet Soup never once competed in his home state.

Based in California, the son of Cozzene made all but two of his 24 starts on the West Coast. For his career, he won 10 times, was second three times and third in six, and counted additional graded stakes wins in the Grade 2 San Antonio, San Pasqual and Del Mar Breeders' Cup Handicaps, as well as the Grade 3 Pat O'Brien and Native Diver Handicaps among his seven added-money victories.

Retired to stud at Adena Springs in Kentucky in 1998, Alphabet Soup has sired the earners of nearly \$41 million and close to 50 stakes winners, led by Dubai Golden Shaheen-G1 winner Our New Recruit and Canadian champions Alpha Bettor and Phantom Light.

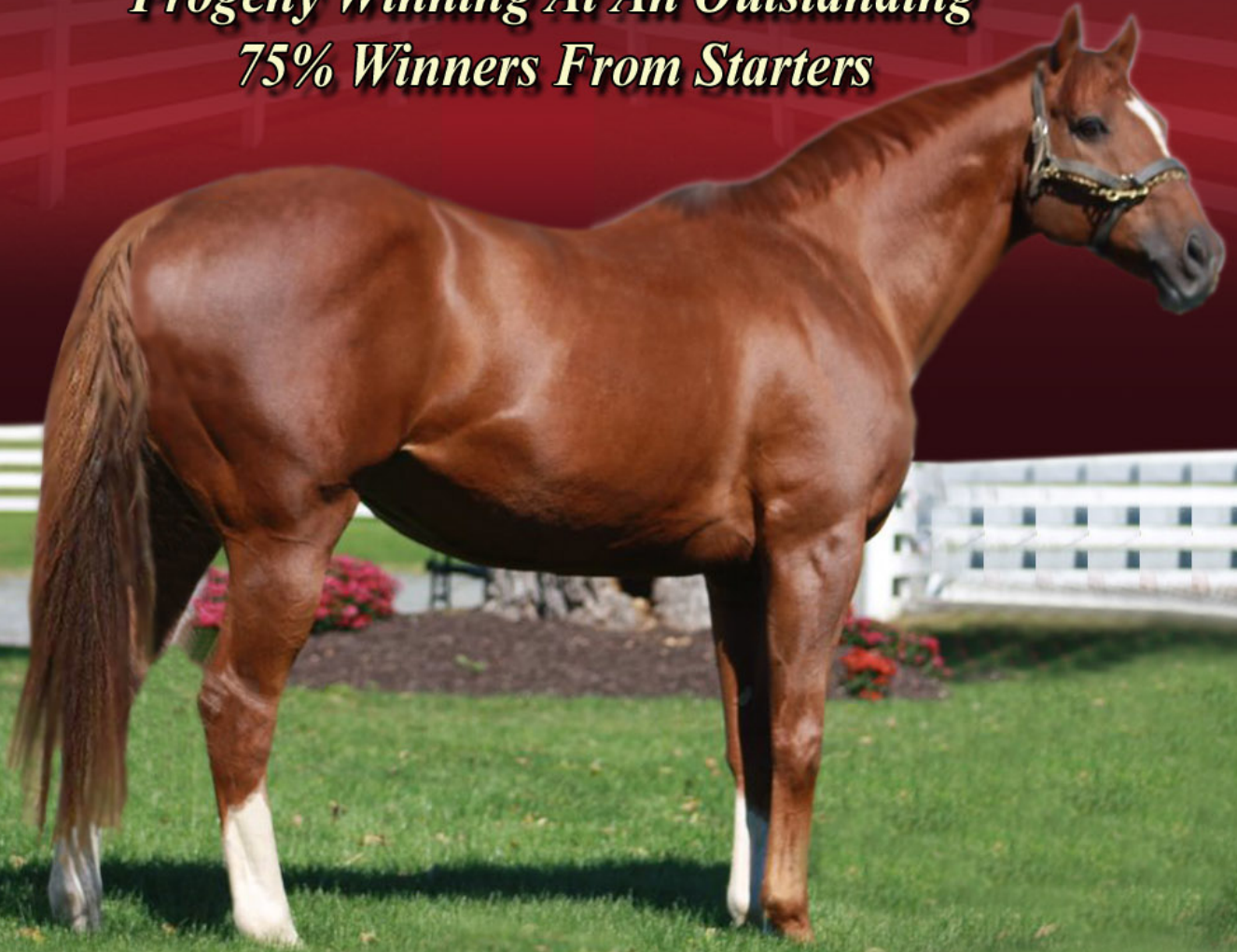
